72	Two commissioners shall be elected from each precinct in the
73	district, and one commissioner shall be elected at large. Each
74	member of the board must, at the time of qualifying for, and
75	during the term of, office, be an elector of Walton County, a
76	resident of the district, and, if elected for a specified seat
77	from a precinct, a resident of the geographical boundary
78	designated for that seat precinct. The board shall elect from
79	its number a chairman, vice chairman, and secretary-treasurer
80	annually in October. Such officers shall have the duties usually
81	pertaining to like officers. Members of the board shall receive
82	no compensation for their service, but they are entitled to
83	reimbursement for expenses incurred in the conduct of their

official duties. Each member of the board, before entering upon the duties of that office, shall execute to the Governor for the benefit of the district a good and sufficient bond in the sum of \$1,000, conditioned to faithfully perform the duties of that office and to account for all funds of the district which come into his or her hands. The premium of the bond shall be paid from funds of the district.
