The Committee on Education Pre-K - 12 (Gaetz) recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

Delete everything after the enacting clause

and insert:

Section 1. Subsection (4) is added to section 1003.42, Florida Statutes, to read:

1003.42 Required instruction.--

(4) Each school district shall notify the parents and the local community, using the district website or other commonly used method of communication, of the instructional standards or course descriptions used by the secondary schools in the school district to teach human sexuality and pregnancy and disease awareness and prevention. The website or other method of communication must include information concerning the available procedures that parents may use to review the curriculum and the methods by which they may provide comments and offer input to the school district.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
