33-15A-07 1 Senate Resolution 2 A resolution recognizing March 13, 2007, as "Chronic Kidney Disease Awareness Day." 3 4 5 WHEREAS, healthy kidneys are essential to regulate the 6 body by water and other chemicals in your blood, remove 7 fluids, waste, toxins, and drugs introduced to the body, 8 release hormones that regulate blood pressure, make red blood 9 cells, and promote strong bones, and WHEREAS, more than 1.8 million Floridians, about one in 10 nine adults, suffer from chronic kidney disease, and 11 12 WHEREAS, of the 19,000 Floridians afflicted with 13 end-stage renal disease, approximately 40 percent are African-American and 16 percent are Hispanic, and 14 WHEREAS, the two main causes of chronic kidney disease 15 are diabetes and high blood pressure, which are responsible 16 17 for up to two-thirds of the cases, and 18 WHEREAS, the National Kidney Foundation of Florida has a health-screening program to identify people early for kidney 19 disease, and 20 WHEREAS, the mission of the National Kidney Foundation 21 22 of Florida is to prevent kidney and urinary tract diseases, 23 improve the health and well-being of individuals and families affected by these diseases, and increase the availability of 2.4 all organs for transplantation, and 25 WHEREAS, early detection including regular reporting of 26 the glomerular filtration rate, currently the best indication 27 2.8 of kidney disease staging, can help prevent the progression of kidney disease to kidney failure, which requires continual 29 30 dialysis or a kidney transplant in order to maintain life, and 31

WHEREAS, the cost of treatment for kidney disease 1 2 patients is disproportionately higher than any other chronic 3 disease, and 4 WHEREAS, most patients who have end-stage renal disease 5 rely primarily on Medicare and Medicaid to cover the costs of 6 their life-sustaining care that includes dialysis treatment, 7 medications, laboratory testing, and, as necessary, 8 transportation services to the dialysis facility, and as a consequence, any changes in Medicare and Medicaid eligibility, 9 10 will significantly put them at risk, NOW, THEREFORE, 11 12 Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Florida: 13 That March 13, 2007, is recognized as "Chronic Kidney 14 Disease Awareness Day" in Florida in the hope that all 15 possible support be extended to chronic kidney disease 16 17 patients in Florida, including expanding the scope of study at the Agency for Health Care Administration to include a study 18 of early screening, diagnosis, and treatment of chronic kidney 19 disease. 20 21 22 23 2.4 25 26 27 28 29 30 31
