The Committee on Regulated Industries (Haridopolos)  
recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 1, lines 20-31, delete those lines

and insert:

(4) Any person seeking a license as an auctioneer must pass a written examination approved by the board which tests his or her general knowledge of the laws of this state relating to provisions of the Uniform Commercial Code that are relevant to auctions, the laws of agency, and the provisions of this act. Each applicant must file a complete set of fingerprints that have been taken by an authorized law enforcement agency or vendor. The Department of Business and Professional Regulations shall submit the fingerprints to the Department of Law Enforcement for state processing, and the Department of Law Enforcement shall forward them to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for national processing. The cost for the fingerprint processing shall be borne by the applicant. The Department of Law Enforcement shall invoice the

1 Department of Business and Professional Regulations for the  
 2 fingerprints submitted each month. The department shall screen  
 3 background results to determine if an applicant meets the  
 4 licensure requirements.
