Section 507.055, Florida Statutes, is created to read: 2 507.055 Written inventory; offer to shipper 3 4 required.--(1) A mover shall offer to prepare at an additional 5 cost to the shipper, a written inventory of all items to be 6 7 moved by the shipper. A shipper may waive, in writing, the preparation of a written inventory which shall be expressed at 8 the time the written estimate for moving and accessorial 9 10 services is prepared and signed by the mover and shipper.
