The Committee on Community Affairs (Haridopolos) recommended  
the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment**

On page 1, lines 13-20, delete those lines

and insert:

(5) Every enclosed space or room containing a boiler that is regulated under chapter 554 and that is fired by the direct application of energy from the combustion of fuels and located in any portion of a public lodging establishment that also contains sleeping rooms must be equipped with one or more carbon monoxide sensor devices bearing the label of a nationally recognized testing laboratory and must have been tested and listed as complying with the most recent Underwriters Laboratories, Inc., Standard 2034, or its equivalent, unless the division has determined that carbon monoxide hazards have otherwise been adequately mitigated.
