7 316.614 Safety belt usage.--

8 (4) It is unlawful for any person:

9 (a) To operate a motor vehicle in this state unless each  
10 passenger and the operator of the vehicle under the age of 21 ~~18~~  
11 years are restrained by a safety belt or by a child restraint  
12 device pursuant to s. 316.613, if applicable; or

13 (8) Any person who violates the provisions of this section  
14 commits a nonmoving violation, punishable as provided in chapter  
15 318. However, except for violations of s. 316.613 and paragraph  
16 (4) (a), enforcement of this section by state or local law
