A bill to be entitled

An act relating to ballot initiatives; amending s. 100.371, F.S.; authorizing private property owners and others to prohibit or regulate activity on their property which opposes or supports ballot initiatives; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (7) is added to section 100.371, Florida Statutes, to read:

100.371 Initiatives; procedure for placement on ballot.--

(7) In addition to any other practice or action that is permitted under law, an owner, lessee, or other person lawfully exercising control over private property may:

(a) Prohibit any person from engaging in an activity on the property which supports or opposes a particular initiative or initiatives in general; or

(b) Allows such activity on the property, but uniformly and reasonably restrict the time, place, and manner in which it takes place.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.

SENATE SUMMARY

Allows property owners and others to prohibit or regulate activity on their property which opposes or supports ballot initiatives.
