The Committee on Criminal Justice (Aronberg) recommended the following **amendment to amendment** (623556):

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 3, between lines 4 and 5,

insert:

Section 4. Subsection (2) of section 960.07, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

960.07 Filing of claims for compensation.--

(2) Except as provided in subsection (3), a claim must be filed not later than 1 year after:

(a) The occurrence of the crime upon which the claim is based.

(b) The death of the victim or intervenor.

(c) The death of the victim or intervenor is determined to be the result of a crime, and the crime occurred after June 30, 1994.

However, for good cause the department may extend the time for filing for a period not exceeding 2 years after such

1 occurrence. For crimes occurring between June 30, 1994, and  
 2 June 30, 2007, the department may also extend until June 30,  
 3 2008, the time for filing when the claimant is a victim of an  
 4 attempt to commit murder and is rendered a paraplegic  
 5 requiring life-supporting or life-sustaining equipment as  
 6 defined in s. 400.925 as a result of the crime.
