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The Committee on Governmental Operations (Wilson) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment

On page 36, line 4, after the period

insert: The rules shall also ensure that:

1. There are opportunities during a hearing for current information to be presented regarding a person's disabilities and needs;

2. Support coordinators, as well as persons with disabilities and their parents, guardians, or authorized representatives are notified simultaneously when an action that can lead to a hearing is taken by the agency or its contractors;

3. Decisions made at a hearing are based on the medical necessity of a service; and

4. If a decision reached at a hearing or subsequent appeal results in the continuation of a service at the current level, such decision is binding until there has been a change in the person's condition which necessitates a review of the

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1 need for the service.

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
