A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the competitive solicitation of contracts; amending s. 287.057, F.S.; requiring that additional types of contracts by state agencies be procured by competitive solicitation; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (27) is added to section 287.057, Florida Statutes, to read:

287.057 Procurement of commodities or contractual services.--

(27) Unless a specific provision of subsection (5) makes a procurement not subject to competitive-solicitation requirements, an agency must procure a contract by competitive solicitation if the contract authorizes a contractor to use governmental authority to provide a service to public or private entities or authorizes a contractor to use government property for the purpose of selling goods or services and if, over the contract term, the sum of estimated gross revenues to be generated under the contract for the state, the contractor, or both exceed the threshold amount for CATEGORY TWO in s. 287.017.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.

STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN
COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
Senate Bill 1976

Clarifies that the procurement exemptions of s. 287.057(5), F.S., are not affected by the bill.
