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The Committee on Environmental Preservation and Conservation  
(Rich) recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment**

On page 20, line 27, through page 21, line 18, delete  
those lines

and insert:

1. ~~The Department of Environmental Protection shall initially allot such certificates to each licenseholder with a current crawfish trap number who uses traps. The number of such certificates allotted to each such licenseholder shall be based on the trap/catch coefficient established pursuant to trip ticket records generated under the provisions of s. 370.06(2) over a 3-year base period ending June 30, 1991. The trap/catch coefficient shall be calculated by dividing the sum of the highest reported single license-year landings up to a maximum of 30,000 pounds for each such licenseholder during the base period by 700,000. Each such licenseholder shall then be allotted the number of certificates derived by dividing his or her highest reported single license-year landings up to a~~

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1 ~~maximum of 30,000 pounds during the base period by the~~  
2 ~~trap/catch coefficient. Nevertheless, no licenseholder with a~~  
3 ~~current crawfish trap number shall be allotted fewer than 10~~  
4 ~~certificates. However, certificates may only be issued to~~  
5 ~~individuals; therefore, all licenseholders other than~~  
6 ~~individual licenseholders shall designate the individual or~~  
7 ~~individuals to whom their certificates will be allotted and~~  
8 ~~the number thereof to each, if more than one. After initial~~
