The 18 19 dealer shall post a cash bond in the amount of the fair value of the entire quantity of unreported or falsely reported spiny 20 <u>lobster</u> crawfish as determined by the judge. After posting the 21 22 cash bond, the dealer shall have 24 hours to transport said products outside the limits of Florida for sale as provided by 23 2.4 s. 370.061. Otherwise, the product shall be declared a nuisance and disposed of by the commission according to law. 25 (3) All dealers having reported stocks of spiny 26 <u>lobster</u> crawfish may sell or offer to sell such stocks of 27 spiny lobster crawfish; however, such dealers shall submit an 28 29 additional report on the last day of each month during the duration of the closed season.
