Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 1, following line 31,

insert:

Section 1. Present subsections (3) and (4) of section 372.16, Florida Statutes, are renumbered as subsections (6) and (7), respectively, and new subsections (3), (4), and (5) are added to that section, to read:

372.16 Private game preserves and farms; penalty.--

(3) Nothing in this section may be construed as restricting or prohibiting the hunting of wildlife as controlled by the state.

(4) A person may not knowingly engage in or sponsor the shooting of an exotic mammal for profit if the exotic mammal is:

(a) Confined in a man-made enclosure, regardless of the size of the enclosure;

(b) Tied, staked, caged, or otherwise restrained from

1 engaging in normal movement; or

2 (c) Released from confinement or restraint in the
3 presence of a person for the purpose of being killed or
4 wounded by that person.

5 (5) A person may not knowingly purchase, sell, import,
