Subsections (4), (5), and (6) of section 322.16, Florida Statutes, are amended and renumbered as 14 subsections (5), (6), and (7), respectively, and a new 15 subsection (4) is added to that section, to read: 16 17 322.16 License restrictions.--(4) A person who holds a driver's license who has not 18 attained 18 years of age shall not operate a motor vehicle 19 with more than one passenger in the vehicle who has not 20 21 attained 18 years of age unless any additional passenger or 22 passengers who have not attained 18 years of age are siblings 23 or children of the driver, whether related by the whole or half blood, by affinity, or by adoption. 2.4 (5)(4) The department may, upon receiving satisfactory 25 evidence of any violation of the restriction upon such a 26 27 license, except a violation of paragraph (1)(d), subsection 2.8 (2), or subsection (3), or subsection (4), suspend or revoke the license, but the licensee is entitled to a hearing as upon 29 a suspension or revocation under this chapter. 30 31
