Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 1, between lines 29 and 30,

insert:

Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 381.005, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as subsection (4), and a new subsection (3) is added to that section, to read:

381.005 Primary and preventive health services.--

(3) Subject to the availability of an adequate supply of the necessary vaccines, between October 1 of each year and February 1 of the following year, or earlier if available, the Department of Health shall offer immunization against the influenza virus and pneumococcal bacteria to all residents, 65 years of age or older, of assisted living facilities licensed under chapter 429, in accordance with the recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and subject to the clinical judgement of the responsible practitioner. By September 1 of each year, the department or its designee shall
