On page 56, line 14, through page 57, line 12, delete
those lines

and insert:

(1) From the annual revenues deposited in the trust
fund, unless otherwise specified in the General Appropriations
Act:

(a)(1) Up to 40 percent shall be used for funding
solid waste activities of the department and other state
agencies, such as providing technical assistance to local
governments and the private sector, performing solid waste
regulatory and enforcement functions, preparing solid waste
documents, and implementing solid waste education programs.

(b)(2) Up to 4.5 percent shall be used for funding
research and training programs relating to solid waste
management through the Center for Solid and Hazardous Waste
Management and other organizations that ~~which~~ can reasonably
