On page 45, between lines 28 and 29,

insert:

Section 22. Section 376.30715, Florida Statutes, is
amended to read:

376.30715 Innocent victim petroleum storage system
restoration.--A contaminated site acquired by the current
property owner prior to July 1, 1990, which has ceased
operating as a petroleum storage or retail business prior to
January 1, 1985, is eligible for financial assistance pursuant
to s. 376.305(6), notwithstanding s. 376.305(6)(a). For the
purposes of this section, "acquired" means the acquisition of
the title to the property, however, a subsequent transfer of
the property to a spouse, a surviving spouse in trust or free
of trust or to a revocable trust created for the benefit of
the settlor, shall not disqualify the site from financial
assistance pursuant to s. 376.305(6). Eligible sites shall be
