Paragraph (eee) is added to subsection (7) 11 12 of section 212.08, Florida Statutes, to read: 13 212.08 Sales, rental, use, consumption, distribution, and storage tax; specified exemptions. -- The sale at retail, 14 the rental, the use, the consumption, the distribution, and 15 the storage to be used or consumed in this state of the 16 17 following are hereby specifically exempt from the tax imposed 18 by this chapter. (7) MISCELLANEOUS EXEMPTIONS. -- Exemptions provided to 19 any entity by this chapter do not inure to any transaction 20 21 that is otherwise taxable under this chapter when payment is 22 made by a representative or employee of the entity by any 23 means, including, but not limited to, cash, check, or credit card, even when that representative or employee is 2.4 subsequently reimbursed by the entity. In addition, exemptions 25 provided to any entity by this subsection do not inure to any 26 27 transaction that is otherwise taxable under this chapter 2.8 unless the entity has obtained a sales tax exemption certificate from the department or the entity obtains or 29 provides other documentation as required by the department. 30 Eligible purchases or leases made with such a certificate must 31 1

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1	be in strict compliance with this subsection and departmental
2	rules, and any person who makes an exempt purchase with a
3	certificate that is not in strict compliance with this
4	subsection and the rules is liable for and shall pay the tax.
5	The department may adopt rules to administer this subsection.
6	(eee) School bookstoresAlso exempt from the tax
7	imposed by this chapter are payments to a postsecondary
8	educational institution by a person who operates a bookstore
9	at a location owned, leased, or otherwise operated on behalf
10	of that institution.
11	Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
12	law and shall operate retroactively to amounts paid on or
13	after January 1, 2006.
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
