(4)(a) A person who violates subsection (2) commits a 19 misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 20 21 775.082 or s. 775.083, Florida Statutes. 22 (b) A person who violates subsection (2) a second or 23 subsequent time commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, Florida 2.4 Statutes. 25 Section 2.
