Senate Memorial

A memorial to the Congress of the United States requesting that it provide a tax exemption for moneys placed into escrow to meet a deductible requirement of an insurance policy against which a claim was made due to a natural disaster.

WHEREAS, in 2004 and 2005, Florida was directly affected by eight named hurricanes, and

WHEREAS, the value of property damaged as a result of these hurricanes reached record levels, with property owners suffering catastrophic losses, and

WHEREAS, the Gulf coastal region, of which this state is a part, has proven susceptible to the threats from hurricanes and tropical storms, which can be expected to cause further damage in the future as coastal areas experience continued development, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes that property owners throughout the region need additional economic relief, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the Congress of the United States is requested to enact legislation that exempts from taxation moneys placed into escrow for the purpose of meeting a deductible requirement of an insurance policy against which a claim has been made as the result of the insured's loss due to a natural disaster.
