The Committee on Health Policy (Dawson) recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 23, between lines 7 and 8,

insert:

Section 22. The Department of Children and Family Services shall complete a study to find the most appropriate model and methods to provide alcohol and substance abuse treatment and prevention services to pregnant women and pregnant minors who place their unborn child at risk for exposure to alcohol or psychotropic or mood-altering substances. The Department of Children and Family Services must present its findings and recommendations to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate by January 1, 2008.

Section 23. The Legislature appropriates \$250,000 of non-recurring funds from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Children and Family Services during Fiscal Year 2007-08 for the completion of the study on ways to provide
