plates; amending s. 320.061, F.S.; conforming provisions; creating s. 320.0615, F.S.; prohibiting certain alteration of license plates to make them unreadable to automated traffic cameras; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 320.061, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
320.061 Unlawful to alter motor vehicle registration certificates, license plates, mobile home stickers, or validation stickers; penalty.--A A person may not shall alter the original appearance of any registration license plate, mobile home sticker, validation sticker, or vehicle registration certificate issued for and assigned to any motor vehicle or mobile home, whether by mutilation, alteration, defacement, or change of color or in any other manner. Except as provided in s. 320.0615 , a Any person who violates the provisions of this section commits of aisdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

Section 2. Section 320.0615, Florida Statutes, is created to read:
320.0615 Motor vehicle license plates; alteration affecting readability by automated traffic cameras; penalty.--
(1) A driver may not alter a motor vehicle license plate with a spray or other coating, covering, film, protective material, or device that distorts angular 1

visibility or detectability; that alters, obscures, or
otherwise interferes with the readability of the letters or
numbers on the plate, the color of the plate, or another
original design feature of the plate; or that makes the plate
unreadable in photographs taken by automated traffic cameras
or electronic photo radar devices.
    (2) Enforcement of this section by state or local law
enforcement agencies must be accomplished only as a secondary
action when a driver of a motor vehicle has been detained for
a suspected violation of another section of chapter 216, this
chapter, or chapter 322.
    (3) Notwithstanding s. 320.061, a violation of this
section is a noncriminal traffic infraction, punishable as a
moving violation as provided in chapter 318.
            Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
