A bill to be entitled
An act relating to missing child
investigations; amending s. 937.021, F.S.;
requiring a state law enforcement agency having
jurisdiction over the case of a missing child
to keep the case open and under active
investigation for a certain period of time;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (4) is added to section 937.021,
Florida Statutes, to read:

937.021 Missing child reports.--

(4) The state law enforcement agency having
jurisdiction over the case of a missing child shall keep the
case open and under active investigation until the location of
the child has been determined or for 100 years, whichever
occurs first.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.

Requires a state law enforcement agency having
jurisdiction over a missing child to keep the case open
and under active investigation for a certain period of
time.
