Paragraph (d) of subsection (4) of section 14 121.055, Florida Statutes, is amended, and paragraph (e) is 15 added to that subsection, to read: 16 17 121.055 Senior Management Service Class.--There is 18 hereby established a separate class of membership within the Florida Retirement System to be known as the "Senior 19 Management Service Class, " which shall become effective 20 21 February 1, 1987. 22 (4)23 (d) A member of the Senior Management Service Class shall receive retirement credit at the rate of 2 percent of 2.4 average final compensation for each year of service in such 25 class between after January 31, 1987, and June 30, 2007. 26 27 (e) A member of the Senior Management Service Class 2.8 shall receive retirement credit at the rate of 2.5 percent of average final compensation for each year of service in such 29 30 class after June 30, 2007. 31
