The 19 report shall include, at a minimum, a description of the 20 extent of the Myakka River area, which may be covered under the designation, and any recommendations or concerns of 21 22 affected parties or other interests. During the development 23 of the report, at least one public hearing shall be held in 2.4 the affected area of Manatee County.
