The Committee on Community Affairs (Hill) recommended the following amendment:

**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

Delete everything after the enacting clause

and insert:

Section 1. Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subsection (7) of section 258.501, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as paragraphs (d) and (e), respectively, and a new paragraph (c) is added to that subsection, to read:

258.501 Myakka River; wild and scenic segment.--

(7) MANAGEMENT COORDINATING COUNCIL.--

(c) The Myakka River Management Coordinating Council shall prepare a report recommending the expansion of the Florida Wild and Scenic River designation to include the entire Myakka River. At a minimum, the report shall include a description of the extent of the Myakka River area that may be covered under the designation and any recommendations or concerns of affected parties or other interests. During the development of the report, at least one public hearing shall

1 be held in each of the affected areas of Manatee and Charlotte  
 2 counties. The report shall be submitted to the Governor, the  
 3 President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of  
 4 Representatives no later than January 1, 2008.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
