10-1475-07 1 A bill to be entitled 2 An act relating to cigarette taxes; amending s. 210.20, F.S.; providing for a portion of the 3 revenues from the cigarette tax to be paid 4 5 monthly to the Board of Directors of the H. Lee б Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute, 7 to finance cancer research, treatment, and 8 related facilities; amending s. 210.201, F.S.; providing for the use of the transferred 9 moneys; providing an effective date. 10 11 12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 13 Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section 14 210.20, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 15 210.20 Employees and assistants; distribution of 16 17 funds.--(2) As collections are received by the division from 18 such cigarette taxes, it shall pay the same into a trust fund 19 in the State Treasury designated "Cigarette Tax Collection 20 21 Trust Fund" which shall be paid and distributed as follows: 22 (b)1. Beginning January 1, 1999, and continuing for 10 23 years thereafter, the division shall from month to month certify to the Chief Financial Officer the amount derived from 2.4 the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, less the service 25 charges provided for in s. 215.20 and less 0.9 percent of the 26 27 amount derived from the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, 2.8 which shall be deposited into the Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco Trust Fund, specifying an amount equal to 2.59 percent 29 of the net collections, and that amount shall be paid to the 30 Board of Directors of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and 31

1 Research Institute, established under s. 1004.43, by warrant drawn by the Chief Financial Officer upon the State Treasury. 2 These funds are hereby appropriated monthly out of the 3 Cigarette Tax Collection Trust Fund, to be used for the 4 purpose of constructing, furnishing, and equipping a cancer 5 6 research facility at the University of South Florida adjacent 7 to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute. In 8 fiscal years 1999-2000 and thereafter with the exception of 9 fiscal year 2008-2009, the appropriation to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute authorized by this 10 subparagraph shall not be less than the amount that would have 11 12 been paid to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research 13 Institute for fiscal year 1998-1999 had payments been made for the entire fiscal year rather than for a 6-month period 14 15 thereof.

2. Beginning July 1, 2002, and continuing through June 16 17 30, 2004, the division shall, in addition to the distribution 18 authorized in subparagraph 1., from month to month certify to the Chief Financial Officer the amount derived from the 19 cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, less the service charges 20 21 provided for in s. 215.20 and less 0.9 percent of the amount 22 derived from the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, which 23 shall be deposited into the Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco Trust Fund, specifying an amount equal to 0.2632 percent of 2.4 the net collections, and that amount shall be paid to the 25 Board of Directors of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and 26 27 Research Institute, established under s. 1004.43, by warrant 2.8 drawn by the Chief Financial Officer. Beginning July 1, 2004, and continuing through June 30, 2016, the division shall, in 29 addition to the distribution authorized in subparagraph 1., 30 from month to month certify to the Chief Financial Officer the 31

1	amount derived from the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02,
2	less the service charges provided for in s. 215.20 and less
3	0.9 percent of the amount derived from the cigarette tax
4	imposed by s. 210.02, which shall be deposited into the
5	Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco Trust Fund, specifying an
6	amount equal to 1.47 percent of the net collections, and that
7	amount shall be paid to the Board of Directors of the H. Lee
8	Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute, established
9	under s. 1004.43, by warrant drawn by the Chief Financial
10	Officer. These funds are appropriated monthly out of the
11	Cigarette Tax Collection Trust Fund, to be used for the
12	purpose of constructing, furnishing, and equipping a cancer
13	research facility at the University of South Florida adjacent
14	to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute. In
15	fiscal years 2004-2005 and thereafter, the appropriation to
16	the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute
17	authorized by this subparagraph shall not be less than the
18	amount that would have been paid to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer
19	Center and Research Institute in fiscal year 2001-2002, had
20	this subparagraph been in effect.
21	3. Beginning on July 1, 2007, and continuing through
22	January 1, 2009, the division shall, in addition to the
23	distribution authorized in subparagraphs 1. and 2., from month
24	to month certify to the Chief Financial Officer the amount
25	derived from the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, less the
26	service charges provided in s. 215.20 and less 0.9 percent of
27	the amount derived from the cigarette tax imposed by s.
28	210.02, which shall be deposited into the Alcoholic Beverage
29	and Tobacco Trust Fund, specifying an amount equal to 0.94
30	percent of the net collections, and that amount shall be paid
31	to the Board of Directors of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center

1	and Research Institute, established under s. 240.512, by
2	warrant drawn by the Chief Financial Officer. Beginning
3	January 1, 2009, and continuing through June 30, 2016, the
4	division shall, in addition to the distribution authorized in
5	subparagraph 2., from month to month certify to the Chief
6	Financial Officer the amount derived from the cigarette tax
7	imposed by s. 210.02, less the service charges provided in s.
8	215.20 and less 0.9 percent of the amount derived from the
9	cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02, which shall be deposited
10	into the Alcoholic Beverage and Tobacco Trust Fund, specifying
11	an amount equal to 3.53 percent of the net collections, and
12	that amount shall be paid to the Board of Directors of the H.
13	Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute by warrant
14	drawn by the Chief Financial Officer. Beginning on July 1,
15	2016, and continuing through June 30, 2037, the division shall
16	from month to month certify to the Chief Financial Officer the
17	amount derived from the cigarette tax imposed by s. 210.02,
18	less the service charges provided in s. 215.20 and less 0.9
19	percent of the amount derived from the cigarette tax imposed
20	by s. 210.02, which shall be deposited into the Alcoholic
21	Beverage and Tobacco Trust Fund, specifying an amount equal to
22	5 percent of the net collections, and that amount shall be
23	paid to the Board of Directors of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer
24	Center and Research Institute by warrant drawn by the Chief
25	Financial Officer. These funds are appropriated monthly out of
26	the Cigarette Tax Collection Trust Fund, to be used for the
27	purpose of constructing, furnishing, and equipping cancer
28	research, treatment, and related facilities. In the 2007-2008
29	fiscal year and thereafter, the appropriation authorized by
30	this subparagraph may not be less than the amount that would
31	have been paid to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and

1	Research Institute in the 2005-2006 fiscal year had this
2	subparagraph been in effect. The funds to be paid to the H.
3	Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute under this
4	section may be pledged to pay bonds issued to fund the cost of
5	the cancer research and treatment facilities described above.
б	It is the intent of the Legislature that to the extent the
7	cigarette tax is amended or repealed in a manner that would
8	adversely affect bonds issued for such purpose, the
9	Legislature will provide alternative funding sources in an
10	amount sufficient to pay any deficit in the amount required
11	for such debt service.
12	Section 2. Section 210.201, Florida Statutes, is
13	amended to read:
14	210.201 Cancer research facility at the University of
15	South Florida; establishment; fundingThe Board of Directors
16	of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute
17	shall construct, furnish, and equip, and shall covenant to
18	complete, the cancer research facility at the University of
19	South Florida adjacent to the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and
20	Research Institute <u>described in s. 210.20(2)(b)1. and 2. and</u>
21	the research, treatment, and related facilities described in
22	<u>s. 210.20(2)(b)3</u> . Moneys transferred to the Board of
23	Directors of the H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center and Research
24	Institute pursuant to s. 210.20 shall be used to secure
25	financing to pay costs related to constructing, furnishing,
26	and equipping the cancer research facility and related
27	facilities. Such financing may include the issuance of tax
28	exempt bonds by a local authority, municipality, or county
29	pursuant to parts II and III of chapter 159. Such bonds shall
30	not constitute state bonds for purposes of s. 11, Art. VII of
31	the State Constitution, but shall constitute bonds of a "local

1	agency," as defined in s. 159.27(4). The cigarette tax dollars
2	pledged to <u>the facilities</u> <del>this facility</del> pursuant to s. 210.20
3	may be replaced annually by the Legislature from tobacco
4	litigation settlement proceeds.
5	Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
