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A bill to be entitled An act relating to public records and public meetings; creating s. 1004.433, F.S.; providing an exemption from public-records requirements for records and information in the possession of Boca Raton Community Hospital, Inc., or a subsidiary thereof, in its capacity as lessee of land from Florida Atlantic University pursuant to an agreement for the implementation of a land lease for the development and operation of a community-university affiliated teaching hospital which will serve as the primary teaching hospital for the regional campus of the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine at Florida Atlantic University; providing an exception to the exemption; providing an exemption from public-meetings requirements for meetings or portions of meetings of the board of directors of Boca Raton Community hospital, or a subsidiary thereof, in its capacity as lessee; providing an exception to the exemption; providing an exemption from public-records requirements for any records generated during those meetings or portions of meetings of the board of directors of Boca Raton Community Hospital, or a subsidiary thereof, which are closed to the public under the act; providing for review and repeal; providing a statement of public necessity; providing an effective date.

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which is confidential and exempt under subsection (2) is 2 closed to the public and exempt from s. 286.011 and s. 24(b), Art. This exemption does not 3 4 apply to a meeting or portion of a meeting of the board of directors of Boca Raton Community Hospital, Inc., or a 5 6 subsidiary thereof, in its capacity as lessee as defined in 7 subsection (1), at which information is presented or discussed 8 that is solely related to the undergraduate medical and graduate medical programs of the University of Miami Miller 9 10 School of Medicine at Florida Atlantic University, which shall be public meetings unless made exempt from public-meetings 11 12 requirements by law. 13 (4) Any records generated during a meeting or portion of a meeting of the board of directors of Boca Raton Community 14 Hospital, Inc., or a subsidiary thereof, in its capacity as 15 lessee as defined in subsection (1), which are closed to the 16 public under subsection (3), such as minutes, tape recordings, 18 videotapes, transcriptions, or notes, are confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24, Art. I of the State 19 Constitution. 2.0 21 This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand 2.2 23 repealed on October 2, 2012, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. 2.4 Section 2. It is the finding of the Legislature that 2.5 it is a public necessity that records and information in the 26 2.7 possession of Boca Raton Community Hospital, Inc., or a 2.8 subsidiary thereof, in its capacity as the lessee of land on the Boca Raton campus of Florida Atlantic University for the 29 development and operation of a community-university affiliated 30 teaching hospital be held confidential and exempt from

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public-records requirements in order for the teaching hospital 2 to fulfill its mission in medical research and education and to ensure that the lessee and its subsidiaries are not placed 3 4 at a disadvantage in a competitive health care environment. These exemptions are necessary because these records contain 5 6 information that, if disclosed, would adversely affect the 7 lessee or its subsidiaries in the competitive health care 8 environment. Disclosure of such records and information would place the lessee and its subsidiaries on an unequal footing in 9 10 the marketplace as compared with private health care providers that are not required to disclose such confidential and exempt 11 12 information. The Legislature finds that the disclosure of such 13 confidential and exempt information would adversely affect the lessee and its subsidiaries in fulfilling their mission of 14 medical treatment, research, and education. The Legislature 15 further finds that it is a public necessity that meetings of 16 17 the board of directors of Boca Raton Community Hospital, Inc., 18 or a subsidiary thereof, in its capacity as lessee be held exempt from public-meetings requirements in order to protect 19 the competitive interests of the lessee and to quarantee the 2.0 21 ability of the lessee to fulfill its medical research and 2.2 teaching mission for the benefit of the public. Consequently, 23 the Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that any records generated during those meetings or portions of 2.4 meetings of the board of directors of Boca Raton Community 2.5 Hospital, Inc., or a subsidiary thereof, in its capacity as 2.6 2.7 lessee which have been made exempt from public-meetings 2.8 requirements under this act, such as minutes, tape recordings, videotapes, transcriptions, or notes, be held confidential and 29 exempt from public-records requirements, since failure to 30

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8	The Committee Substitute creates public records and meetings exemptions in the School Code for records and meetings of the
9	board of directors of Boca Raton Community Hospital, Inc., and its subsidiaries.
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11	Records and information in the possession of the hospital are confidential and exempt from public records requirements
12	except those records that pertain to medical education at the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine at Florida
13	Atlantic University.
14	Meetings of the hospital board are exempt from public meetings requirements except those meetings or portions of meetings
15	where medical education at the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine at Florida Atlantic University is
16	discussed.
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
