An act relating to firefighter pensions; amending s. 175.032, F.S.; revising the definition of the term "special fire control district" to include certain community development districts performing fire suppression and related services; amending s. 190.011, F.S.; authorizing community development districts to levy the premium tax; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (16) of section 175.032, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

175.032 Definitions.--For any municipality, special fire control district, chapter plan, local law municipality, local law special fire control district, or local law plan under this chapter, the following words and phrases have the following meanings:

district, as defined in s. 189.403(1), established for the purposes of extinguishing fires, protecting life, and protecting property within the incorporated or unincorporated portions of any county or combination of counties, or within any combination of incorporated and unincorporated portions of any county or combination of counties. The term includes community development districts providing fire suppression and related services pursuant to s. 190.012(2)(b). The term does not include any dependent or independent special district, as defined in s.
