23	(d) A certified or registered contractor, or a
24	contractor authorized by a local construction licensing board,
25	may not perform work for which he or she is not properly
26	licensed, subcontract to unlicensed persons to perform work

The procedure for issuing a civil citation as provided in this paragraph does not authorize a local jurisdiction to exercise disciplinary authority against a state-certified contractor. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007. \*\*\*\*\* SENATE SUMMARY Prohibits a certified or registered contractor from performing work for which the contractor is not properly licensed or from subcontracting work to an unlicensed person to perform work that requires a license. Authorizes local jurisdictions to issue civil citations for violations of certain specified building laws. Provides exceptions. 

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
