20	(1) For a primary English instructor who is an
21	English/language arts teacher, 300 inservice hours or the
22	equivalent.
23	(2) For an instructor teaching the core curriculum
24	subjects of reading, intensive reading, mathematics, science,
25	social studies, or computer literacy, 60 inservice hours or
26	the equivalent.
27	(3) For an instructor teaching noncore curriculum
28	subjects, 18 inservice hours or the equivalent.
29	(4) For a school administrator or quidance counselor,
30	60 inservice hours or the equivalent.
31	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
