29 The name of the limited liability company must be (2) distinguishable on the records of the Division of Corporations 30 of the Department of State, except for fictitious name 31 registrations filed pursuant to s. 865.09 and general 32 33 partnership registrations filed pursuant to s. 620.8105; 34 however, a limited liability company may register under a name that is not otherwise distinguishable on the records of the 35 Division of Corporations with written consent of the owner 36 entity provided the consent is filed with the Division of 37 Corporations at the time of registration of such name. 38

39 <u>(3)(2)</u> The name of the limited liability company shall be 40 filed with the Department of State for public notice only and 41 shall not alone create any presumption of ownership beyond that 42 which is created under the common law. The Department of State 43 shall record the name without regard to any other name recorded.
