A bill to be entitled

An act relating to public transit providers;
creating s. 341.065, F.S.; requiring such
providers to give restroom breaks to their
drivers or operators of public conveyances;
providing an exception; providing an effective
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 341.065, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

341.065 Public transit providers; required restroom
breaks.--

(1) A public transit provider must give each driver or
operator of a public conveyance in the transit system a paid
restroom break of not less than 10 minutes for each 4-hour
period or major part of such period worked.

(2) However, a public transit provider may provide
appropriate restroom break periods, pursuant to a collective
bargaining agreement, which differ from those required in this
section.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.

SENATE SUMMARY

Requires public transit providers to give restroom breaks
to drivers or operators of the conveyances in the system.
