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5	WHEREAS, tens of thousands of individuals across the
6	United States are reliant upon plasma protein therapies and
7	recombinant analogs, known as "plasma protein therapies," to
8	treat rare life-threatening genetic and autoimmune disorders,
9	and
10	WHEREAS, several hundred individuals in the State of
11	Florida have been diagnosed with one of these rare disorders,
12	and
13	WHEREAS, these disorders, including, but not limited
14	to, hemophilia and other bleeding disorders, primary
15	immunodeficiency diseases, and alpha-1 antitrypsin deficiency,
16	are most effectively treated with plasma protein therapies,
17	and
18	WHEREAS, individuals afflicted with these disorders
19	need access to the full range of plasma protein therapies to
20	help ensure the best possible clinical outcomes, and
21	WHEREAS, these individuals require access to the
22	appropriate providers and designated centers of excellence
23	appropriate to their health care needs, and
24	WHEREAS, these individuals need access to options in
25	pharmacy and the delivery of home-supported services, and
26	WHEREAS, access to comprehensive care has been shown to
27	markedly improve patient outcomes, NOW, THEREFORE,

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That the month of April 2007 is recognized as "Plasma
