The Committee on Criminal Justice (Aronberg) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 22, between lines 16 and 17,

insert:

Section 10. (1) The owner, operator, or primary agent of a bail bond agency may provide electronic monitoring equipment and services for defendants released from custody on surety bond and subject to conditions including electronic monitoring.

(2) A bail bond agent may charge a person subject to electronic monitoring a nonrefundable fee for such monitoring equipment and services. Such fees are not part of the bail bond premium and are exempt from s. 648.33, Florida Statutes.

(3) Records and receipts for such electronic monitoring equipment and services shall be kept separate from bail bond records and shall be made available for inspection by the court or appropriate governmental entity.
