A bill to be entitled

An act relating to child care facilities;
amending s. 402.305, F.S.; requiring each child
care facility to establish standards for
instructing child care personnel on matters
pertaining to domestic violence; requiring that
the instruction include a specified training
period for new and experienced child care
personnel; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (h) is added to subsection (2) of
section 402.305, Florida Statutes, to read:

402.305 Licensing standards; child care facilities.--

(2) PERSONNEL.--Minimum standards for child care
personnel shall include minimum requirements as to:

(h) Issues of domestic violence. Each child care
facility must establish standards for instruction for training
child care personnel on matters pertaining to domestic
violence. The instruction must include not less than 2 hours
of training for new child care personnel and not less than 1
hour of instruction on a periodic and timely basis for
experienced child care personnel each year thereafter.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.

SENATE SUMMARY

Requires each child care facility to establish standards
for instructing child care personnel on matters
pertaining to domestic violence. Requires that the
instruction include not less than a specified training
period for new and experienced child care personnel.
