Appropriations (Margolis) recommended the following **amendment**
to amendment (484876):

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 1, line 18, through
page 58, line 6, delete those lines

and insert:

Section 1. The tax levied under chapter 212, Florida
Statutes, may not be collected during the 14-day period
beginning at 12:01 a.m., on the first Saturday in October
2007, on the sale of a new energy-efficient product having a
selling price of \$1,500 or less per product during that
period. This exemption applies only when the energy-efficient
product is purchased for noncommercial home or personal use
and does not apply when the product is purchased for trade,
business, or resale. As used in this section, the term
"energy-efficient product" means a dishwasher, clothes washer,
air conditioner, ceiling fan, compact florescent light bulb,
dehumidifier, programmable thermostat, or refrigerator that

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1 has been designated by the United States Environmental
2 Protection Agency or by the United States Department of Energy
3 as meeting or exceeding the requirements under the Energy Star
4 Program of either agency. Purchases made under this subsection
5 may not be made using a business or company credit or debit
6 card or check. Any construction company, building contractor,
7 or commercial business or entity that purchases or attempts to
8 purchase the energy-efficient products as exempt under this
9 section commits the offense of engaging in an unfair method of
10 competition in violation of s. 501.204, Florida Statutes,
11 punishable as provided in s. 501.2075, Florida Statutes.
12 Notwithstanding chapter 120, Florida Statutes, the Department
13 of Revenue may adopt rules to administer this section.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
15 law.

31 purchases or attempts to purchase are unfair

2 authorizing the Department of Revenue to adopt
3 rules; providing an effective date.
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
