The program shall operate through formal 23 agreements between law enforcement and education agencies. The primary objectives of the program are to prevent gang 2.4 membership and the delinquency and violence associated with 25 gang activity. At a minimum, the program shall be designed to: 26 27 (a) Provide children with the skills necessary to 2.8 combat the stresses that set the stage for gang involvement. (b) Provide children with accurate knowledge about 29 30 gang involvement. 31
