A bill to be entitled 2 An act relating to immunizations; amending ss. 3 402.305, 402.313, and 402.3131, F.S.; adding 4 pneumococcal conjugate vaccine to the list of 5 required vaccines for enrollment in a child 6 care facility, a family day care home, or a 7 large family child care home; requiring the Department of Health to establish rules and 8 9 protocols; requiring facilities and homes to 10 furnish proof of compliance to the department; providing an effective date. 11 12 13 WHEREAS, the State of Florida recognizes the importance of pneumococcal conjugate vaccine for children enrolled or 14 enrolling in child care programs, and 15 WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Health, Bureau of 16 17 Immunization, acknowledges that vaccines, including pneumococcal conjugate vaccine, focus on disease prevention 18 and are the most cost-effective medical intervention, and 19 WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and 20 21 Prevention, through the Advisory Committee on Immunization 22 Practices, recommends that children be administered 23 age-appropriate four-dose series of pneumococcal conjugate vaccine, and 2.4 WHEREAS, pneumococcal conjugate vaccine, which is 25 licensed by the United States Food and Drug Administration, is 26 27 effective in preventing invasive pneumococcal disease, and 28 WHEREAS, a recent study published in the Journal of the American Medical Association reveals that pneumococcal 29 conjugate vaccine, when administered to children, has 30 significantly reduced the number of invasive pneumococcal

disease cases and deaths in the adult population, NOW, 2 THEREFORE, 3 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 4 5 6 Section 1.
