9	Section 4. During the 2007-2008 school year, the State
10	Board of Education shall review and revise the Sunshine State
11	Standards related to physical education skills to reflect
12	state-of-the-art philosophy and practice. The revised
13	standards shall emphasize the role of physical education in
14	promoting the knowledge, skills, and attitudes that prepare
