The Committee on Health Policy (Dawson) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 3, between lines 10 and 11,

insert:

Section 6. Each public elementary, middle, and high school in this state shall post in a conspicuous place in its cafeteria and on the school website the nutritional value of every meal served in the cafeteria. Such posting must be accessible to a parent of each student. If a public elementary, middle, or high school serves fried foods, such fried foods must be fried in oils that are low in trans fatty acids in order to reduce the development of health abnormalities in children.
