Veterans Service Organization 23 license plates must bear the colors and design approved by the 24 25 department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the name of the respective veterans service 26 27 organization must appear at the bottom of the plate. 38	(b) The department shall retain all revenues from the sale
39	of such plates until all startup costs for developing and
40	issuing the plates have been recovered. Thereafter, 60 percent
41	of the annual use fees shall be remitted to the appropriate
42	organization to support its veterans and military activities,
43	programs, and projects within the state. The remaining 40
44	percent shall be deposited into the State Homes for Veterans
45	Trust Fund and used solely to construct, operate, and maintain
46	domiciliary and nursing homes for veterans subject to the
47	requirements of chapter 216.
