A bill to be entitled 2 An act relating to Florida State University; 3 providing for the relief of Dennis Darling, 4 Sr., and Wendy Smith, parents of Devaughn 5 Darling, deceased, for the loss of their son, 6 Devaughn Darling, while he was engaged in 7 football preseason training on the Florida 8 State University campus; providing an 9 appropriation; providing an effective date. 10 WHEREAS, on February 21, 2001, Devaughn Darling 11 12 collapsed and died while participating in preseason training 13 in preparation for the upcoming football season at Florida State University, and 14 WHEREAS, after litigation had ensued and during 15 mediation, the parents of Devaughn Darling and Florida State 16 University agreed to compromise and settle all of the disputed 18 claims rather than continue with litigation and its attendant uncertainties, and 19 WHEREAS, the parties resolved, compromised, and settled 20 21 all claims by a stipulated settlement agreement that provided 22 for the entry of a consent final judgment against Florida 23 State University in the amount of \$2 million, of which the Division of Risk Management of the Department of Financial 2.4 Services has paid the sum of \$200,000, the limit under s. 25 768.28, Florida Statutes, and 26 27 WHEREAS, as provided by the settlement agreement, the 2.8 remaining unpaid portion of the consent judgment, \$1.8 29 million, is sought to be paid to the plaintiffs by the filing 30 of this claim bill and the university's support thereof 31

2	THEREFORE,
3	
4	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:
5	
6	Section 1. The facts stated in the preamble to this
7	act are found and declared to be true.
8	Section 2. The sum of \$1.8 million is appropriated out
9	of funds in the General Revenue Fund not otherwise encumbered,
10	to be paid to Wendy Smith and Dennis Darling, Sr., parents of
11	decedent Devaughn Darling, as relief for their losses.
12	Section 3. The Chief Financial Officer is directed to
13	draw a warrant in favor of Wendy Smith and Dennis Darling,
14	Sr., parents of Devaughn Darling, deceased, in the sum of \$1.8
15	million upon funds in the State Treasury and to pay the same
16	out of such funds in the State Treasury.
17	Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
18	law.
