**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 5, between lines 13 and 14,

insert:

Section 3. Paragraph (d) of subsection (7) of section  
468.609, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

468.609 Administration of this part; standards for  
certification; additional categories of certification.--

(7)

(d) A newly employed or hired person may perform the  
duties of a plans examiner or building code inspector for 120  
~~90~~ days if a provisional certificate application has been  
submitted, provided such person is under the direct  
supervision of a certified building code administrator who  
holds a standard certification and who has found such person  
qualified for a provisional certificate. However, direct  
supervision and the determination of qualifications under this

 2 holds a limited or provisional certificate in any county with  
 3 a population of less than 75,000 and in any municipality
