This act shall take effect July 1, 2007. 19 STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN 20 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR 21 Senate Bill 2848 22 The committee substitute (CS) prohibits a county from 23 requiring a municipality formed after January 1, 2000, to pay 2.4 a charge, assessment, tax, fee, or other consideration as a condition of incorporation. This is a change from the bill as 25 filed which applied the prohibition to any municipality formed after January 1, 2002. The CS also moves this prohibition from 26 s. 125.0101, F.S., to an unnumbered section of law. 27 2.8 29 30 31
