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The Committee on Regulated Industries (King) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 6, between lines 14 and 15,

insert:

Section 5. Subsection (6) is added to section 497.270, Florida Statutes, to read:

497.270 Minimum acreage; sale or disposition of cemetery lands.--

(6) Except for a road system or a transportation corridor, or for right-of-way purposes, property dedicated for use as a cemetery and licensed under this part may not be taken by eminent domain if the area of the property is one 1 contiguous acre or more, unless the taking entity determines in a public hearing that there is no reasonable alternative. A governmental entity may not require the transfer of property dedicated for cemetery purposes and licensed as of July 1, 2007, as a condition of obtaining approval for any regulatory requirement to which the cemetery is subject.
