| 17 | WHEREAS, for those persons who have suffered a loss of         |
| 18 | a pregnancy or infant, a day of remembrance and reflection     |
| 19 | would be more than just a day to remember, it would be a day   |
| 20 | that would validate their loss, and                            |
| 21 | WHEREAS, because of the nature of miscarriages and             |
| 22 | stillbirths and the lack of understanding of pregnancy loss    |
| 23 | and infant death, families that suffer these tragedies must    |
| 24 | often bear their pain and sorrow in private without an         |
| 25 | opportunity to grieve openly, and                              |
| 26 | WHEREAS, support from family, friends, and the                 |
| 27 | community is vital to individuals and families who are coping  |
| 28 | with the loss of a pregnancy or child, and                     |
