18	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

20	Section 1. Minimum content requirement for biodiesel
21	fuel
22	(1) The Legislature finds that it is vital to the
23	public interest and to the state's economy to establish a
24	market for alternative fuels in this state by requiring that
25	diesel fuel offered for sale in this state include renewable
26	biofuel meeting applicable standards for fuel quality. The
27	Legislature finds that the use of biodiesel fuel reduces
28	dependence on imports of foreign oil, improves the health and
29	quality of life for Floridians, and stimulates the creation of
30	a new industry that combines agricultural production with
31	state-of-the-art technology.

1 (2) As used in this section, the term "biodiesel fuel" 2 means a renewable, biodegradable, mono-alkyl ester combustible liquid fuel that is derived from agricultural plants, oils, or 3 4 animal fats and that meets specifications of the American Society for Testing and Materials for biodiesel fuel B100 5 6 blend stock for distillate fuels, designation D6751-02. 7 (3) All diesel fuel sold or offered for sale in this 8 state for use in an internal combustion engine must contain, 9 at minimum, 5 percent biodiesel fuel by volume. This 10 subsection takes effect on the th day after the Commissioner of Agriculture publishes notice in the Florida 11 12 Administrative Weekly indicating that the annual capacity for 13 the production of biodiesel fuel in this state exceeds gallons. 14 (4) The requirements of subsection (3) do not apply if 15 fuel sold or offered for sale is to be used in: 16 17 (a) A motor at an electric power plant that is 18 regulated by the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission unless such commission has approved the use of fuel meeting 19 the requirements of subsection (3); 20 21 (b) A railroad locomotive; or 2.2 (c) Equipment, including a vehicle or vessel, covered 23 by a warranty that would be voided if it were to be operated using fuel meeting the requirements of subsection (3). 2.4 (5) Each refinery and terminal shall provide, at the 25 time diesel fuel is sold or transferred from the refinery or 26 27 terminal, a bill of lading or shipping manifest to the person 2.8 receiving the fuel. For biodiesel-blended products, the bill of lading or shipping manifest must disclose biodiesel 29 content, stating volume percentage, gallons of biodiesel per 30 gallons of petroleum diesel base-stock, or an ASTM "xx" 31

designation for which "xx" denotes the volume percent of 1 2 biodiesel included in the biodiesel-blended product. This 3 subsection does not not apply to a sale or transfer of a 4 biodiesel blend stock between refineries, between terminals, 5 or between a refinery and a terminal. б Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 7 law. 8 9 10 SENATE SUMMARY 11 Requires that diesel fuel sold or offered for sale in this state contain a specified minimum volume of 12 biodiesel after the Commissioner of Agriculture publishes notice concerning biodiesel production capacity. Provides 13 an exemption if the fuel is to be used in certain equipment.
