14-2064-07 1 Senate Resolution 2 A resolution honoring the University of 3 Florida. 4 5 WHEREAS, the University of Florida, a member of the 6 prestigious American Association of Universities, is the best 7 public university in Florida and one of the top 20 public 8 universities in the nation, as measured by U.S. News & World 9 Report, and 10 WHEREAS, the university is the state's leading research and educational institution, drawing \$518 million in research 11 12 grants during the last fiscal year and offering more than 100 13 bachelor's degree programs and more than 200 graduate and professional degree programs, and 14 WHEREAS, these programs make the university, together 15 with its Health Science Center and Institute of Food and 16 17 Agricultural Sciences, one of the most comprehensive in the 18 nation, and 19 WHEREAS, the University of Florida was selected last year as the site for two Centers of Excellence for research on 20 21 energy and nanotechnology and one National Science Foundation 22 research center on high performance computing, and 23 WHEREAS, the University of Florida is home to many of the state's most state-of-the-art research facilities, 2.4 including the recently completed Cancer & Genetics Research 25 26 Complex, the largest research building in the State of 27 Florida, and 2.8 WHEREAS, the University of Florida is the alma mater of Bob Vila, host of several nationally televised 29 home-improvement programs, including "Bob Vila," "Bob Vila's 30 31

1 Home Again, " and "This Old House" and a 1969 graduate of UF's 2 College of Journalism and Communications, and WHEREAS, the university is a major economic engine 3 4 creating an economic ripple effect worth more than \$4 billion, many times the state's investment, and 5 6 WHEREAS, the university serves as a vital engine for 7 the state's technology economy, with companies based on its 8 technologies contributing nearly \$500 million annually to 9 Florida's economy, and WHEREAS, the University of Florida is the 10 top-performing public institution at transferring its research 11 12 to the marketplace according to the prestigious Milken 13 Institute 2006 rankings, and WHEREAS, the university is home to some of the nation's 14 top faculty members, including more than two dozen who have 15 been selected to the National Academies, the Institute of 16 17 Medicine, or a counterpart in a foreign nation, and the 18 university has more than 50 eminent-scholar chairs, and WHEREAS, the university, as one of the five largest in 19 the country, attracts some of the best students in the nation, 20 21 ranking 1st among universities worldwide in the numbers of 22 International Baccalaureate students who attend its campus, 23 and producing the second-highest number of PhDs in the nation, 2.4 and 25 WHEREAS, the university's students are steadily becoming more diverse, with 13 percent of its freshman class 26 27 African-Americans and 14 percent Hispanic, and the University 2.8 of Florida in 2006 awarded the third highest number of PhDs to 29 African-Americans among all public universities, and 30 WHEREAS, UF athletes are among the most talented in the nation, and UF most recently finished sixth in national 31
